



Mr. Bermann serves as the Superintendent of Schools. He has held this position since December 2007, and reports directly to the Board of Education. Mr. Bermann is responsible and the successful implementation of curricula and instruction as mandated by the State of New Jersey and the effective operation of the district.

Mr. Bermann has had a long and varied history here at Pittsgrove, having served in the district since September 1967, when he began his career at Norma School as an elementary/junior high school teacher and Job Placement Coordinator until 1979. He subsequently served as Adult High School Principal, Director of Community School, High School

Supervisor and Supervisor of Buildings & Grounds until his appointment as Business Administrator/Board Secretary in 1983. Under his tenure as Business Administrator, the district witnessed the building of the Middle School and the Administration Building, extensive renovations at Schalick High School and Olivet School to improve energy efficiency and ADA compliance, the implementation of the Township's Small Cities Grant to construct a Senior Citizen Community Center at Norma School, and the purchase of the Thornthwaite Building to house the district's special education offices and the shared services operations which he anchored since its inception in 1993.
